Aconite vs. Ferrum phos

Similarities: pulse, fever, thirst, sweetish taste

Differences: TONGUE (Acon = pale, Ferr-p = dark red) ...IRRIATION: Acon = throat, Ferr-p = sternum ... Acon = 1st 24-36 hours (of being sick), Ferr phos 1st 3+ days

Ferrum phos is MORE TIRED, want to be alone/be quiet | Aconite is TERRIFIED esp. of dying, wants someone there all the time,

Aconite vs. Belladonna

Similarities: onset, red face, heat, burning fever | Differences: pupils (sensitivity to light), thirst, side (lungs).

Acon. Is more anxious/terrified of death, Belladonna more delusional/exciteable and cryin gout

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
